# **Environmental Economics, Policy and International Environmental Relations**

**of PhD. students, young scientists and researchers**

**Date of the conference: 19-20 November 2015**

**Venue: University of Economics, W. Churchill Square 4, Prague 3**

### **The key topic:**

Up-to-date theoretical or/and practical issues of environmental economics, policy, and management. Topics with an international environmental relations dimension are welcome, but it is not a condition. Since the conference strongly focuses on science-policy interface, every paper must discuss the potential of factual contribution and potential impact of the findings for a policy decision-making support.

**Publishing options:** All accepted papers will be printed and bind in the Book of working papers, which will be distributed at the conference. The papers will be reviewed by two anonymous reviewers. Selected high quality papers presented at the conference will be published in a form of book with ISBN number and send to authors by post after the conference or they will be submitted to Reuters as Conference Proceedings for Coverage in the Conference Proceedings Citation Index (CPCI). Another option is to submit selected papers to the European Offroads of Social Science journal. The final decision about the publications will be made by participants at the conference. The consultant of PhD student may be listed as co-author, but the young scientist must be listed as the first author.
